ENCOMPASS YOUTH HUB

At the Langley Youth Hub, any youth in our community will find acceptance and care under one roof. The Hub provides opportunities to meet the basic needs of youth such as food, showers, laundry, and toiletries. We also provide services such as medical care, substance use counselling and harm reduction programs, mental health counselling, employment and housing support, and life skills training - all of which are imperative in increasing the overall well-being of youth. The services and programs of the Hub are provided in-kind through our partner organizations.



WEEKEND FUELBAG

We currently help 80 students at 9 different high schools and middle schools in Langley. There is a waiting list of 25 students. Weekend Fuelbag is made possible by the generous funding of our sponsors and partners to continue to grow and help as many students to achieve a brighter future.

Our vision is that all students have access to the same opportunities to be successful. It takes a caring community to create change, every person can, and must step up and be the difference-maker that will benefit all of society.
